

3. Map: useful pointers

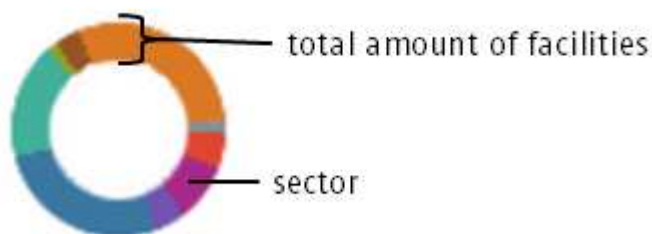
User instructions for map

In the map view you can choose between individual facility view or chart view as a display format. The standard setting is chart view. You can switch to individual facility view by clicking on the individual facility button or by selecting one or more sectors.

- Searching for individual facilities

Chart view

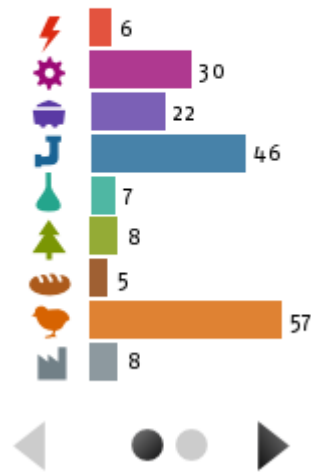
The chart view features a pie chart which shows the number and industry distribution of facilities. This chart view is available for the *Land* and district level. The different colour shades represent the breakdown of the sectors. The width of the pie chart on the *Land* level reflects the number of facilities in that *Land* relative to the total number of facilities in Germany. The district level view reflects the number of the district's facilities relative to total number of facilities in the respective *Land*.



Clicking on the pie chart will open a window which displays the number of facilities in the individual sectors of industry. The arrow navigation at the bottom of the window will switch to the view of each sector's share of all facilities in Germany or in the *Land*. There is a zoom in/zoom out function at the bottom right corner of the window.

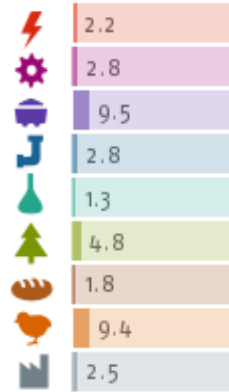

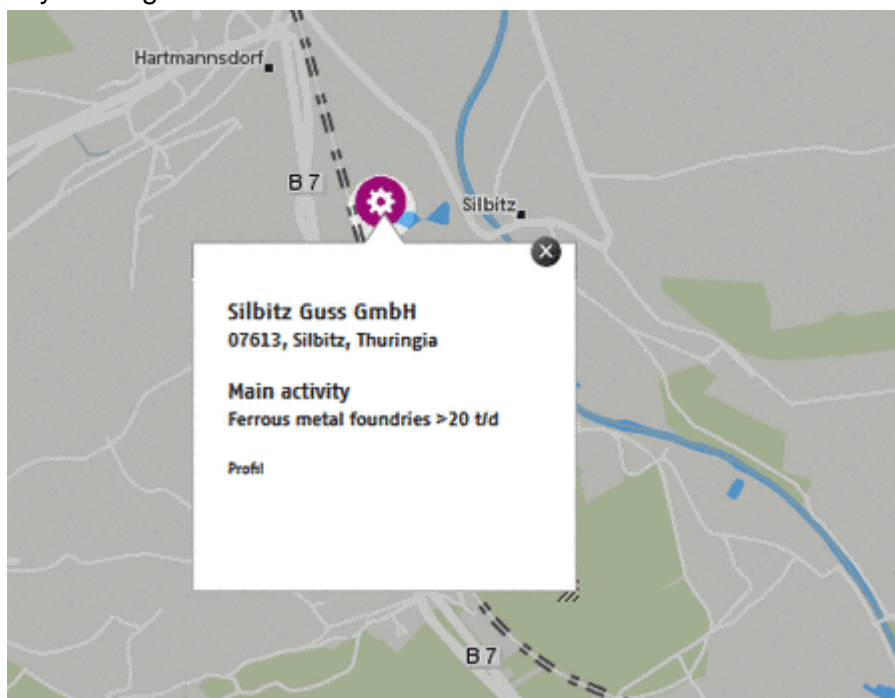
Percentage (%) of all facilities per sector in 2012



As of a scale of 1:150,000, the chart view also shows individual facilities. Detailed information about the facilities and their overall profile can be accessed by clicking on the individual icons.

Individual facility

The individual facility view shows all PRTR facilities with the icon representing the respective industry sector. Individual sectors can be added in or excluded. Switching between both views (individual facility and chart) is possible up to a scale of 1:250,000. Data on the individual facility, or detailed information, can be accessed at a scale setting of 1:150,000 and higher. Detailed information about the facilities and their overall profile can be accessed by clicking on the individual icons.



Pointers about search boxes in the map

You can use three additional search boxes to support your map search:

- **Reporting year:**

The reporting year is pre-set to the year with the most recent data.

- **Search town/city / postal code:**

You can enter any postal code or town/city (in Germany) in this search box. Please select the postal code or name of town from the pull-down menu that will open and click on the zoom button behind the search box. Your selected town or postal code area will be displayed to a scale of 1:50,000. You can click directly on the facilities in the pane to access the detail view.

- **Search facility:**

You can enter the facility name that you are looking for in this search box. A number of names will be suggested as you make your entry. Select your facility of choice and click on the zoom button behind the search box. The selected facility will be displayed to a scale of 1:20,000. You can click on the facilities in the pane to access the detail view.

Nothing happens when I click on the facility icons on the map. What am I doing wrong?

Detailed information about facilities as well as their overall profile can be accessed by clicking on the individual icons. This function is only available at scale 1:150,000 or greater.

You can change the map scale by clicking on "-" or "+" in the upper left corner of the zoom bar in the map. The current map scale setting is shown at the bottom right of the map.

How do I get more detailed information about a facility on the map?

Detailed information about facilities can be accessed by clicking on the individual icons in the map at a scale of 1:150,000 or greater. A small window will open with key information about the facility. Click on "Profile" in this window to see the detailed information.
